SUBJECT: Bid Reassignments with Less Than Eight Hours Between Tours

TO: Paul Lanzi, Director, City Operations

On March 16, 1988, a Step II grievance settlement was reached between the Postal Service and the APWU concerning reassignments to new bids with less than eight (8) hours between tours. The following language will govern these reassignments.

When an employee is awarded a bid and the reassignment to the new bid would not allow eight (8) hours between tours, the employee will have the option of taking annual leave, leave without pay (LWOP), schedule change, or delaying the reassignment to their non-scheduled days.

The employee's supervisor will contact the affected employee to make these arrangements in a timely manner.

I understand that this subject is currently being discussed at a higher level, therefore, this language may be modified by the result of those discussions.
