

The subject Step 2 grievance was discussed with you on September 3, 1985, in accordance with Article 15, Section 2, of the National Agreement.

Based upon the facts and arguments presented by the Union, I find that Management has, as alleged in this grievance, breached the terms and conditions of the National Agreement.

Management cannot consistently require members of an MPLSM crew to work 2 hours and 25 minutes between rest breaks. Management should consider adjusting the starting time so as to avoid a conflict between break schedules and dispatch schedules for PL 307

Accordingly, this grievance is resolved.
