SUBJECT: Dual Overtime Desired Lists (Trial Period)  
TO: All Supervisors - Des Moines, Iowa Post Office

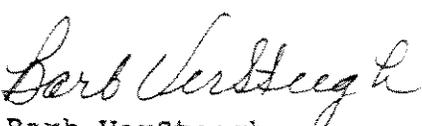
On a six (6) month trial basis, the Des Moines, Iowa, installation will be implementing a dual overtime desired list system for APWU employees. There will be two (2) separate overtime desired lists, one for non-scheduled day overtime, and one for begin tour/end tour overtime. On March 17, 1992, when the second quarter overtime desired list is posted, two sign-up sheets shall be posted to allow employees to sign one or the other or both.

When, during this quarter, the need for overtime arises, the supervisor shall go to the **appropriate** list to select the employees needed for overtime. Each list (non-scheduled day and BT/ET) will be handled separately. There will be a separate overtime rotation for each list.

These lists shall still be established by section, tour and skills required, as in the past.

After the April through June overtime quarter, the Manager of Labor Relations and the President of the DMI-APWU will review the grievance activity and the process in general with input from the supervisors and stewards and a decision on the continuation of the pilot program will be made prior to the end of the July through September 1992 quarter.
