SUBJECT: Code of Ethical Conduct - Gambling  
  
TO: ALL EMPLOYEES

All employees are reminded of the Code of Ethical Conduct (ELM 660) and what is expected and required of them in performing their official duties and as it relates to their conduct in general. Gambling on Postal owned or leased property is prohibited as stated in ELM 661.56, which follows:

"No employee while on property owned or leased by the Postal Service or the United States or while on duty will participate in any gambling activity. This includes the operation of a gambling device, conducting or acting as an agent for a lottery or pool, conducting a game for money or property, or selling or purchasing a numbers slip or ticket."

Employees who violate this section are subjecting themselves to administrative disciplinary action, which may result in removal from the USPS.
