

The subject Step 2 grievance was discussed with you in accordance with Article 15, Section 2, of the National Agreement. This letter will confirm our settlement of this grievance.

As a complete and final settlement of the subject grievance, and without prejudice to the position of either party in this or any other case, and with the understanding that neither party shall cite this settlement in any other grievance proceeding or any other forum, the following resolution has been arrived at between the parties:

Efforts are being made by management to return ill and injured employees to their respective crafts, work facilities, hours and days off. Prior to assigning light and limited duty employees across craft lines, outside their facility, hours or days off, it will be discussed with the union president/designee. Meetings between management and union will be held on an as-needed basis to update the union on the current status of the assignment of the light/limited duty employees.

This settlement represents the complete and final resolution of the subject grievance and all issues pertaining thereto.
